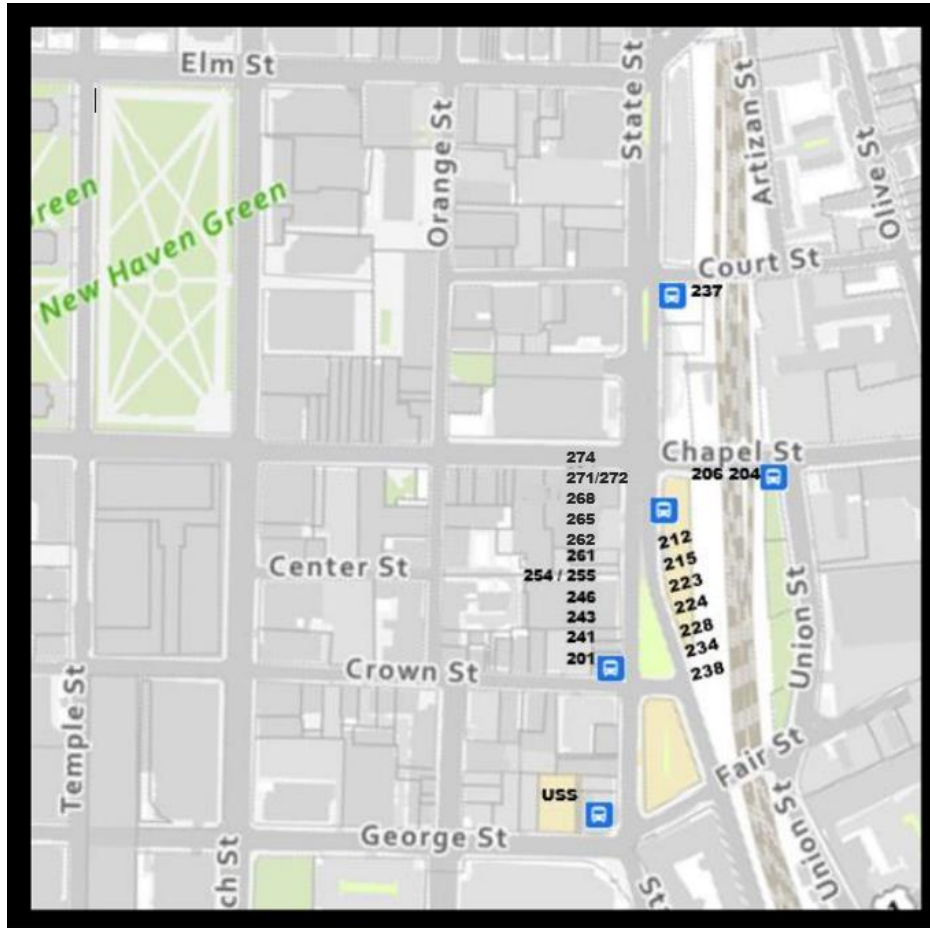

On September 7, 2024, the city of New Haven will be hosting the 14th Annual Closer to Free Ride Bike Race. The bike race fuels research and care at Smilow Cancer Hospital and Yale Cancer Center. The course ranges from 10 to 100 miles long and covers a large geographical area around the downtown New Haven area. The bike race operates along major street arteries and due to street closures, mass detours will be in effect from early 6 am until 11 am. Please plan accordingly and anticipate delays.

Downtown New Haven bus stops will be inaccessible due to Bike Race street closures. please board and alight these routes at the following locations:

State St. Northbound between Fair St. & Chapel St.: 212, 215, 223, 224, 228, 234, 238

State St. Northbound between Chapel St. & Court St.: 237

State St. Southbound Between Chapel St. & Crown St.: 201, 241, 243, 246, 245, 254, 255, 261, 262, 265, 268, 271, 272, 274

State St. Southbound between Crown St. & George St.: Union Station Shuttle

Chapel St. between State St. & Union St.: 204, 206

Due to Bike Race street closures. the following Routes will be impacted please be advised that your stop temporarily may not be serviced:

Route 224

Intermediate bus stops from Downtown New Haven to State Street and Willow Street will not be serviced.

Route 228 & 229

Intermediate bus stops from Downtown New Haven to Whitney Avenue & Augur Street is not serviced.

Route 234

Outbound intermediate bus stops from Downtown New Haven to Davenport Apartments will not be serviced.

Inbound intermediate bus stops from Winchester Avenue and Webster Avenue to Downtown New Haven will not be serviced.

Route 237

Outbound intermediate bus stops from Downtown New Haven to Shelton Avenue and Goodrich Street will not be serviced.

Inbound intermediate bus stops from Broad and Park Street to Downtown New Haven will not be serviced.

Route 238

Outbound intermediate bus stops from Downtown New Haven to Dixwell Avenue & Putnam Avenue will not be serviced.

Inbound intermediate bus stops from Broad and Park Street to Downtown New Haven will not be serviced.

Route 241

Outbound stops will not be serviced, board or alight along inbound route.

Inbound intermediate bus stops from Broad and Park Street to Downtown New Haven will not be serviced.

Route 243

Outbound intermediate bus stops from Downtown New Haven to Westville Center will not be serviced.

Inbound intermediate bus stops from Broad and Park Street to Downtown New Haven will not be serviced.

Route 246

Outbound intermediate bus stops from Downtown New Haven to Alden Avenue & Edgewood Avenue will not be serviced.

Inbound intermediate bus stops from Howe Street and Elm Street to Downtown New Haven will not be serviced.

Route 254

No service on Chapel Street.

Route 255

Intermediate bus stops from Downtown New Haven to Derby Avenue & Forest Road will not be serviced.

Route 261

Intermediate bus stops from Downtown New Haven to the Boston Post Road and Ella T. Grasso Boulevard will not be serviced.

Route 262

Intermediate bus stops from Downtown New Haven to will not be serviced.

Route 265

Intermediate bus stops from Downtown New Haven to Congress Avenue & Howard Avenue will not be serviced.
